Transition Program

We recognise the value of a smooth transition between Year 6 & 7. We have a great program called "It's Your Move" which is a national resource. We offer a package to Primary and Secondary Schools of assemblies, lessons and a free student booklet.

SMSC Support

Question Point is an informal voluntary lunchtime activity. It consists of an SMSC question. Students are invited to respond to an open ended question in survey form. Example questions used have been "What gives you hope in life?", "Who are your role models", "What is true forgiveness?"
